#### 1. God loves you dearly.

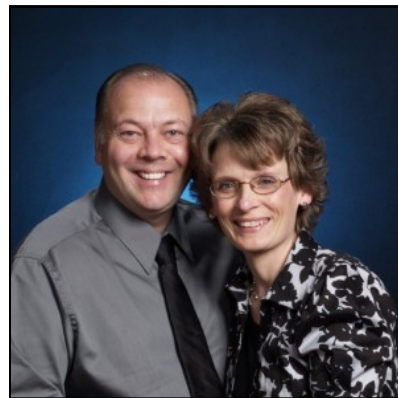
## WELCOME TO HILLSIDE
