WELCOME TO HILLSIDE

New to Hillside? Our ushers have an information packet that we would like you to have. It will help you get acquainted with our church. We are excited that you are our guests; we would love to greet you after the service!

Job's **character** (Job 1:15) was blameless and upright as one who feared God and hated evil. However. despite doing everything right, great calamity strikes Job (Job. 1:8-2:10). Job loses almost everything—his flocks and servants die. Even worse, Job's 10 children are killed. Job's so-called comforters (Job 2:11-13) arrive to mourn with him and his wife for seven days. Then, Job's "friends" open their mouths—providing more harm than help. For the bulk of the book (Job 3-37) Job complains to God. His complaints to God can be categorized into three themes:

- God is silent—He does not respond to me
- God is unjust—He does not relieve my suffering
- God is unconcerned—He does not reward me for my innocence

In Job 38, God finally breaks His silence and speaks directly to Job. God asks a series of 70+ questions that Job cannot answer. In Job 38:1-18, God instructs Job showing Job's ignorance and God's greatness. He essentially says to Job, "I am God. You are not. I know what I am doing in the universe (and in your life). Trust me." God does speak. God is just. God is sovereign.
