"The Great Commission", Part 2

In Matthew 28:19-20, we find the mission Jesus gave us, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age" (Matthew 28:19-20).

It is through the preaching of the gospel that we make disciples or that people become followers of Christ (Acts 14:21-22). The gospel is the good news that Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for our sins on the cross, was buried, and rose again the third day from the dead. The benefits of the gospel including the forgiveness of sin, the gift of righteousness, and eternal life cannot be earned by works, but must be received as a gift (Romans 6:23). We are saved by God's grace, through repentance of sin and faith in Christ alone, that is, apart from works! Even repentance and faith are gifts God bestows.

People become disciples when they repent of their sins and trust in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. Our mission is not fulfilled at this point, but also includes baptizing those who become disciples and teaching them to observe all that Jesus commanded, including making disciples! That is our mission! To make disciples from all the nations seems like a daunting task, but it is a mission that is possible because Jesus, Who was given all authority, promised to be with us to the end of the age, and to the ends of the earth!

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth (Acts 1:8).

Adult Sunday School: The final vision or prophecy of the book of Daniel is found in chapters 10-12. Daniel 10:1-11:1 is an introduction to the main vision or prophecy which is found in 11:2-12:3. Daniel 12:4-13 (the end of the book) contains God's closing instructions to Daniel, and information concerning the timing of the fulfillment of this final vision. We are presently studying Daniel 11:5-35 which was prophecy to Daniel and still in his future, but is history to us. This portion of Scripture is concerned with the wars between the kings of the North (the Seleucid kingdom or Syria) and the kings of the South (the Ptolemaic kingdom or Egypt), and the effects they had on Israel who was in the middle.
