FIVE THINGS GOD WANTS YOU TO KNOW:

1. God loves you dearly.

John 3:16 “For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.”

2. We are all sinners and need to be saved.

Romans 3:23 “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”

3. God provided the only way of salvation.

Romans 5:8 “but God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”

4. Salvation is not earned. It is a gift.

"The Great Commission", Part 3

In Matthew 28:19-20, we find the mission Jesus gave us, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age" (Matthew 28:19-20).

It is through the preaching of the gospel that we make disciples or that people become followers of Christ (Acts 14:21-22). The gospel is the good news that Jesus Christ, the Son of God, died for our sins on the cross, was buried, and rose again the third day from the dead. The benefits of the gospel including the forgiveness of sin, the gift of righteousness, and eternal life cannot be earned by works, but must be received as a gift (Romans 6:23). We are saved by God's grace, through repentance of sin and faith in Christ alone, that is, apart from works! Even repentance and faith are gifts God bestows.

People become disciples when they repent of their sins and trust in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. Our mission is not fulfilled at this point, but also includes baptizing those who become disciples and teaching them to observe all that Jesus commanded, including making disciples! That is our mission! To make disciples from all the nations seems like a daunting task, but it is a mission that is possible because Jesus, Who was given all authority, promised to be with us to the end of the age, and to the ends of the earth!

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth (Acts 1:8).

Adult Sunday School: In the Old Testament God gave us many stories. These stories are not so much about great people as they are about ordinary people who served a great God. We encountered two such stories in Daniel. In chapter 3 we studied the account of God delivering Daniel's three friends, Shadrach, Meshach and Abed-Nego from the fiery furnace, and in chapter 6 the account of God saving Daniel from a den of lions. These stories are ultimately about God, and were written to show His glory! Today, we will take a break from Daniel and look at a well known story which is found in 1 Samuel 17, the account of David and Goliath. The defeat of the Philistines including their champion, Goliath, was ordained by God so "that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel" (1 Samuel 17:46).
