The Trinity

As Christians, we should grow in our knowledge of God. Among the prayer requests Paul made for the believers in Christ at Colossae was that they may increase in their knowledge of God (Colossians 1:10). Though the word "trinity" is not found in the Bible, it is one of the core truths about God in the Bible. In essence, the Trinity is the doctrine that God is one and He eternally exists as the three persons of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. The Bible is clear that there is one God. "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one!" (Deuteronomy 6:4). Each of the three persons of the Trinity is God (1Peter 1:3; John 1:1-3, 14; Acts 5:3-4). There are not three Gods, but one God as three persons. The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit are equally God, each of them possess the attributes of God, but they do have different roles. Let's increase in our knowledge of God by better understanding the Trinity!

Adult Sunday School: Though Daniel's prophecy in 11:2-35 has been fulfilled, the fulfillment of the rest of the chapter's prophecy is probably still in our future. The main character of Daniel 11:36-45 seems to be the future king who is perhaps also known in the Scriptures as Antichrist (1John 2:18), the man of lawlessness (2 Thess. 2:3), and one of the beasts of Revelation 13 (cf. Dan. 7:11). Perhaps, what is indicated in Daniel 11:44-45 is the battle of Armageddon at which time the Antichrist will be cast into the lake of fire (Rev. 16:16, 19:17-21; cf. Joel 3:1-2, 9-16; Zec 14:1-5).
