Baptized Into Christ

The baptism of a believer symbolizes his union with Christ which took place at his conversion (Romans 6:1-6). Because the believer was baptized into Christ, he was also baptized into His death (vs. 3). The believer died with Christ, was buried with Christ, and was raised from the dead with Christ. (Romans 6:4-5) The one who is baptized testifies to the truth that his old sinful way of life has come to an end; it is dead and buried. He has also been raised from the dead and is a new person in Christ. He no longer lives in sin, but has been freed from it, and now walks in newness of life.

Adult Sunday School: Here at Hillside, we practice Believer Baptism. That is, we only baptize those who have a credible testimony of faith in Christ. The pattern we observe in the book of Acts is clear: hearing the Word or the gospel of Christ, believing in Christ and then being baptized, in that order (2:37-38, 40-41, 8:12 -13, 10:44-48/ 11:15-17, 16:13-15, 25-34, 18:8, 19:1-5). We will look at a few of those verses today, and we will also consider the debate concerning the practice of infant baptism.

Operation Christmas Child: We packed 83 boxes full of toys, shirts, toothbrushes, notes, love, and prayers! We sent a check for \$830 to cover collecting, processing, and shipping to over 170 countries as well as ministry materials including The Greatest Gift Gospel Booklet.
