the proper management of my life including my time, talents, and possessions, in order to glorify God and advance His work on earth

Principle #1 God is the owner; I am the steward.

PRINCIPLE #2 GIVING IS A MATTER OF THE HEART.

- Jesus talked about money in 16 of 38 parables.
- The Bible devotes 500 verses on prayer; less than 500 verses on faith; but over 2, 000 verses on money and possessions!
- Giving is a spiritual issue; it's a matter of the heart.
- It is not how much you have that determines your giving, it is how much God has of you!

The Lord Jesus Taught This Principle In Matthew 6:19-21

Matthew 6:19-21 => WHAT YOU DO WITH YOUR MONEY IS AN INDICATION OF WHERE YOUR HEART IS.

Two commands.....

1. "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth"

Stop laying up earthly treasures!

- "for yourselves" to have one's own interest or advantage in mind.
- Treasures hoarded on earth have no lasting or eternal value.
- It may be destroyed by moths or rust, or stolen by thieves.
- 2. "But lay up for yourselves treasure in heaven."
 - How do I lay up treasure in heaven? = Matthew 19:21; I Timothy 6:17-19
 - It's a lasting investment!
 - It will also be for your benefit.

the reason for the two commands......

Where my treasure is, there you will find my heart!

- 1. Giving is a matter of the heart!
- 2. Where your treasure is there will be your heart.
- 3. Lay up treasure in heaven by sharing it on earth.
