The Way to Give

Today we will consider the last three Biblically based principles of stewardship. The focus of these three stewardship principles is giving.

Principle #4: Giving Must Be Consistent. On the first day of the week let each one of you lay something aside, storing up as he may prosper, that there be no collections when I come. (1 Corinthians 16:2)
