The First Fruits of Our Increase

The third of the six stewardship principles we are considering is, "We must honor God by giving Him the first part of our income." In Proverbs 3:9-10 we read, "Honor the LORD with your possessions, and with the firstfruits of all your increase; ¹⁰ So your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will overflow with new wine." Before spending our money on other things, we should first set aside the portion of our income that we have purposed to give to the Lord and His work.

The question is often asked, "What portion of my income should I give to the Lord?" Many Christians give ten percent of their income though the New Testament does not command that we tithe. The New Testament does not demand tithing but rather says, "So let each one give as he purposes in his heart." (See 2 Cor. 9:7) So, we must purpose to give something to the Lord which for many is around ten percent, and we should set it aside as the first thing out of our income each pay period.

God blesses those who give according to this principle! The blessings may not always be material but may often be spiritual.
