A Christian’s Day in Court

The Lord prohibits a Christian from taking another Christian to court (1 Corinthians 6:1-8). Through the pen of Paul, He instructs the local church to decide these matters between believers rather than going to court to have unbelievers render a judgment. The Lord has given the church the authority to hear these cases and render verdicts to which the parties are bound. A believer must be prepared to be wronged or cheated rather than bring a lawsuit against a brother or sister in Christ.

Adult Sunday School: In John’s Gospel we observe the goal toward which the narrative is moving. That goal is the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. This goal or ultimate purpose for which Christ came is indicated early in story with the words of John the Baptist, “Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!” (see 1:29). In John, this goal or end is referred to as Christ’s hour. In Christ’s reply to his mother’s concern that the wine was gone at a wedding feast they both attended, He said, “My hour has not yet come.” (2:4) In the gospel we observe the movement toward that hour in a number of ways.
