### 1. God loves you dearly.

John 3:16 “For God so loved the world, that He gave His only be-gotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have ever-lasting life.”

### 2. We are all sinners and need to be saved.

Romans 3:23 “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”

### 3. God provided the only way of sal-vation.

“Flee Sexual Immorality”

We must flee from sexual immorality! We must not go right up to the line of committing it but immediately flee the moment it presents itself. We must not go places whether actual places or online sites where we may be tempted. Paul wrote in another place, “Let us walk properly, as in the day, not in revelry and drunkenness, not in lewdness and lust, not in strife and envy. <sup>14</sup> But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.” (Romans 13:13-14)

I Corinthians 6:18-20 gives us three reasons why we must flee from sexual immorality. He who commits sexual immorality sins against his own body (vs. 18). A Christian’s body is the temple of the Holy Spirit (vs. 19). We are not our own for Christ bought us with the price of His own blood on the cross (vv. 19-20).

**Adult Sunday School:** One of the emphases of John’s gospel is the signs Jesus performed. John preferred the word sign when writing of Jesus’ miracles. A “sign” pointed to something more significant than the miracle itself. John included signs in his gospel so that people might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and have eternal life in His name (John 2:30-31).
