## FIVE THINGS GOD WANTS YOU TO KNOW:

### 1. God loves you dearly.

John 3:16 “For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.”

### **Do Christians Have Rights?**

In this passage, Paul wrote of his right as an apostle to receive material support for his ministry (1 Corinthians 9:1-18). With respect to his ministry to the Corinthians, he refused the right to receive compensation for his labors. It seems that he did this to be an example to the Corinthians who had the right or liberty before God to eat meat offered to idols, but should forego that right if exercising their Christian liberty would be detrimental to the spiritual lives of others in the congregation (1 Cor. 8).

**Adult Sunday School:** In part 2 of our study on the deity of Christ from John's gospel we plan to consider John 8:31-59 where Jesus indicated His deity in at least three ways. He claimed to be able to set people free from sin (vv. 31-36)- only God can do that! Jesus' question in verse 46 indicates His sinlessness! Only God is without sin! He also used the language of deity in verse 58, "Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM."
