This week Pastor Howard is preaching on Luke 11:1-13. God’s Blessing commentary summarizes it this way:

Jesus is showing us the importance of prayer and the attitude we should have when we pray in this verse. Jesus emphasizes the significance of communication with God by instructing his disciples on how to pray. He is reminding us that prayer is not just about asking for things, but also about acknowledging and honoring God, seeking His will, and aligning our hearts with His.

Jesus’ encouragement to be persistent in prayer highlights the idea that we should not give up easily or lose hope when we don’t see immediate answers to our prayers. We demonstrate our faith and trust in God’s timing and sovereignty by persisting in prayer. It also allows us to cultivate a deeper relationship with God and grow in our understanding of His will for our lives.

So, as we reflect on this verse, let us consider how we approach prayer in our own lives. Are we consistent in seeking God through prayer? Do we approach prayer with humility and reverence, acknowledging God’s greatness and sovereignty? And are we willing to persist in prayer, trusting that God hears us and will answer according to His perfect plan? Let’s challenge ourselves to deepen our prayer life and cultivate a closer connection with our heavenly Father.
