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FIVE THINGS GOD WANTS YOU TO KNOW:

1. God loves you dearly.

John 3:16 “For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.”

2. We are all sinners and need to be saved.

Romans 3:23 “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”

3. God provided the only way of salvation.

Romans 5:8 “but God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”

Today's "Old Testament Gem" is Deuteronomy 6:5. Christianity path summarizes it this way:

In Deuteronomy 6:5, we are given one of the most important commandments in the Bible. This verse emphasizes the core principle of loving God wholeheartedly. Loving God is not just about surface-level emotions; it requires us to engage our entire being – our heart, soul, and strength. The heart represents our emotions, desires, and will. It is the seat of our passions. The soul embodies our inner self, and it's the part of us that connects deeper with God. Finally, our strength signifies all our actions and efforts. When we love God with all three, we prioritize Him above everything else in our lives.

This commandment highlights the importance of having a devoted relationship with God. It isn't restricted to mere words or rituals. It is a living, breathing love that motivates our actions and choices. God desires for us to fully commit ourselves to Him, aligning our heart's desires with His. Loving God should also lead to loving others. As He fills our hearts with love, we are called to share that love with those around us. In essence, this verse is about the total devotion of ourselves – mentally, emotionally, and physically – in pursuit of our relationship with God.
