Be Like Christ summarizes it this way: Psalm 23 is a short, six-verse song by King David that portrays God as a caring shepherd and a generous host.

Main Themes

- **Provision:** God gives food, rest, and calm water ("green pastures" and "still waters").
- **Protection:** God guides and comforts people through hard times ("valley of the shadow of death") using a shepherd's tools.
- **Peace:** God offers safety and abundant blessings even when facing enemies ("my cup runneth over").
- **Presence:** The psalm ends with the promise that God's goodness and mercy will stay with the believer forever.
